Since the February 28th Board meeting, I have spoken with Alexandra Chaney from VDOT hoping that she could clarify the difference between the right-of-way shown by USGS and the one shown from VDOT project records. Alex told me the VDOT right-of-way is most likely the correct one. However, she said that old plans show approximate locations on a sketch. According to Alex, the County simply needs to show a sketch of the approximate location of the right-of-way, and that any action taken must state that 0.16 miles is being abandoned. Alex said that "Section 7" does not need to be a part of the wording, as we would abandon the remainder of the right-of-way. Based on her comments, I have provided a "sketch" showing where the 0.16 miles (844.8 ft) is located. While doing the approximate location, I discovered that a 3rd property owner could be affected by the abandonment. That property owner does not have to be party to the petition, but we will have to notify them if there is a public hearing held. I have asked Mr. Bell to provide the property owner's information, per the policy.

During the February 28th Board meeting to discuss this abandonment request, questions and comments were posed that I would like to address:

1. It was asked if deed searches have been done to make sure no other property owners are involved.

Response: The petition states that only three (3) parcels are involved. My research shows that an additional parcel may be involved, and I have asked Mr. Bell to provide their information.

2. A comment was made that a title search should have caught this, and it should have been worked on at that time.

Response: A title search was performed in 2022 prior to Mr. Bell and Ms. Huff purchasing the property. They, along with attorney Harrison Schroeder, contacted me in February of 2022 to begin this process.

3. When was the house built?

Response: According to Concise, the house was built in 1955.

4. The question was asked how someone could allow them to build a house on a County owned right-of-way. A comment was made that the right-of-way doesn't go through the home, just the property.

Response: I don't have an answer to the placement of the house. As to where the right-of-way runs through the property, the USGS map does not show it going through the house. It shows it following the driveway. However, VDOT records show that the approximate location of Old Bent Mtn Pk. does go through the structure. VDOT is most likely closer to the actual location.

5. Will this landlock somebody if abandoned?

Response: No. The parcels identified in the petition, plus the potential additional parcel, all have frontage on U.S. 221. Mr. Bell and Ms. Huff also have access from Jacks Mill Rd.

6. Did we try to get in touch with Mr. Bell and Ms. Huff in FL?

Response: I have been in email contact with Mr. Bell. On January 27, 2023, I emailed and requested a copy of the USGS map that he referred to in his letter, as well as pictures of the property. On February 14, Mr. Bell emailed me that someone would be taking pictures for him. On March 1, I emailed Mr. Bell to let him know that the Board tabled the request until the March meeting due to not receiving the pictures. He emailed the pictures to me within two hours. I asked if he would be back in Virginia on March 14. When he said yes, I suggested that he attend the March 14 meeting to answer any questions that you may have.

7. Did I contact Mr. Ravan?

I have not contacted Mr. Ravan

8. Is there a clearer copy of the 1936 map?

The document that was shown during the meeting was the up-close USGS map. I have included a copy that I hope is clearer. However, the USGS map most likely does not show the correct location.

9. A comment was made that letters had to be sent out to potential property owners and the property has to be posted.

Response: As the abandonment of Old Bent Mtn Pk does not affect any property except for those in the petition – plus the additional parcel, I will need to ask Steve if notifications are required to be made to anyone other than 10-177, which is not party to the petition. Our policy does state that the property must be posted for at least 30 days prior to the public hearing.

This report includes pictures that were provided by Mr. Bell, an updated copy of the USGS map, and a sketch of the approximate location of Old Bent Mountain Pk, and a marked up copy of the plat that was approved last year for the Bell/Huff property.

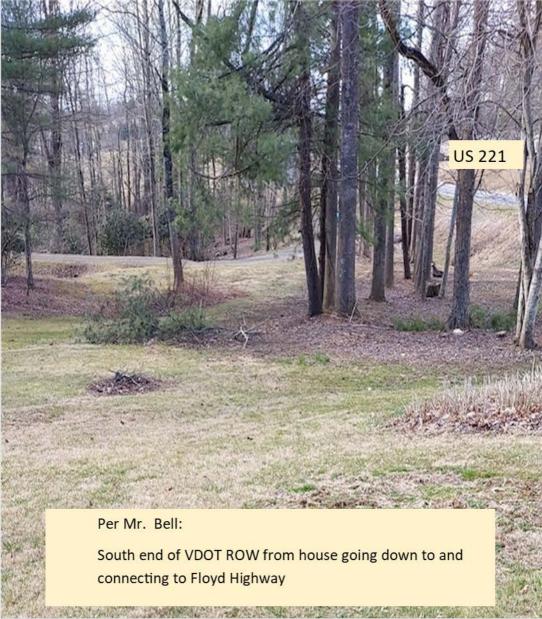
Staff asks that the Board make an initial decision whether to accept the petition and proceed to public hearing, or to reject the petition. Should the Board want to proceed to a public hearing, staff asks that you set a public hearing date at least 45 days from the date of the decision to proceed, as our policy requires the property to be posted for at least 30 days prior to the public hearing. The petitioner will need to pay a \$200 application fee within ten (10) days of the date that the Board moves to go to public hearing. The petitioner will also be responsible for the cost of advertising, the cost of mail notifications, and any other cost that the County incurs regarding this request.

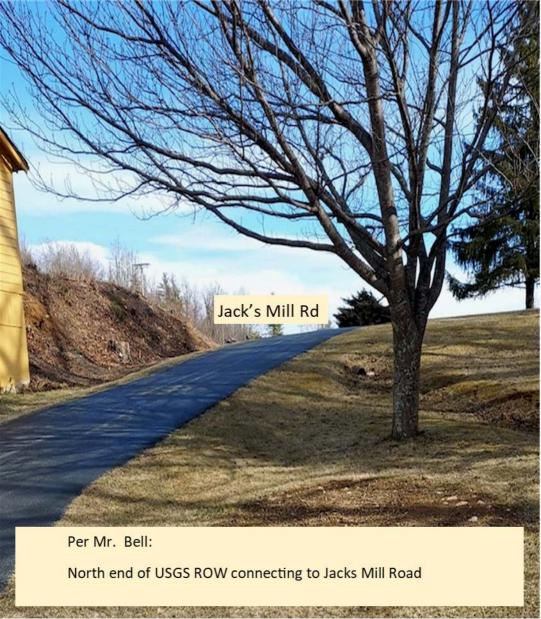


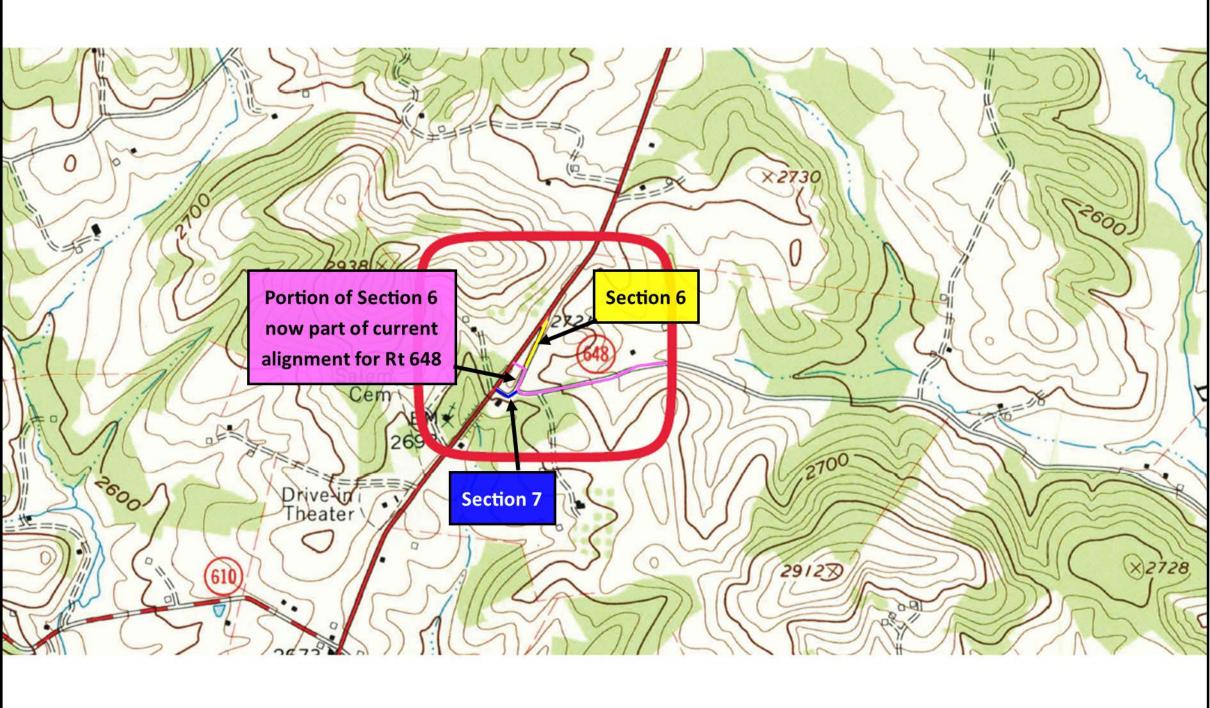


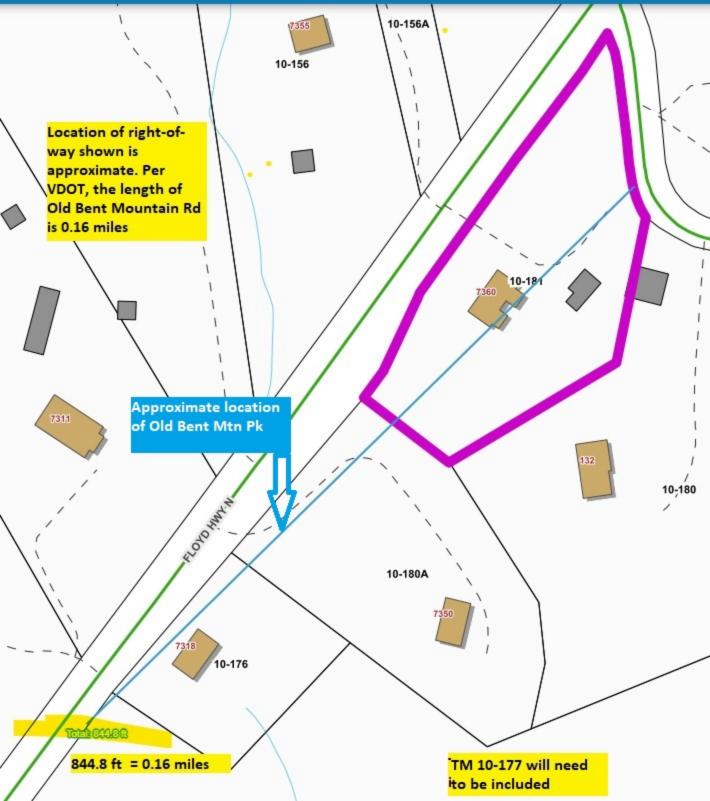


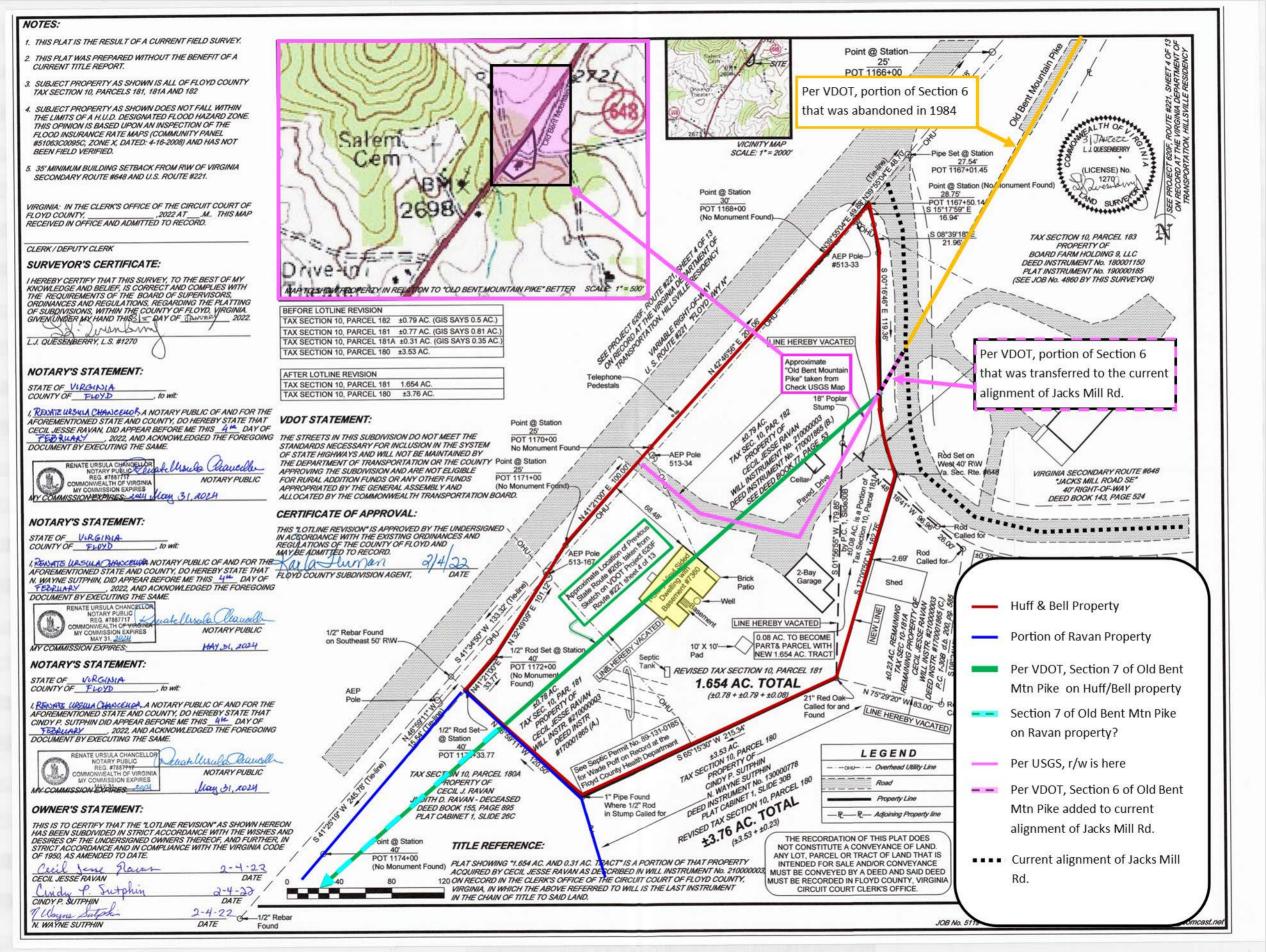
USGS ROW that turns and connects back to Floyd Highway
