G. R. Report: G.R. Ingram reported that we would have at least 8 Officers of Election for each Precinct.
Absentee Ballot Pre-processing as required by the State Board will take place as follows:

June 13th, 10:00 a.m. In the downstairs Jury Room, and
June 17th, 10:00 a.m., Same location.

Canvass to be conducted on Wednesday, June 21st, 10:00 a.m., with Mail-in Absentee Canvass to
follow on Friday, June 17th at 12 noon.

On Motion by R. Smith, second by B. Howell, and approved by acclamation, the Officers of Election will
at the closing of the polls, open Absentee dropboxes and inform the Registrar's Office if ballots are
present. Procedure as follows:

If ballots **are not** contained, the form so indicating will be completed, sealed inside, and the Box will
be returned by the Chief that evening.

If ballots **are** contained, and after all SORs and Tapes have been signed, the form so indicating will
be completed, sealed inside with ballots received, and 2 Officers, of opposite parties, will be sent
immediately to return the Box to the G.R.'s Office.

On Motion by B. Howell, second by R. Smith, and adopted by acclamation, the area within 40 ft. of the
entrance to Polling Place is a "prohibited area", no campaigning permitted. During Curbside Voting, any
Automobile where voting occurs is deemed to be a Polling Place. Officers of Election will enforce the
40 ft. zone for the entire voting process of each instance of Curbside Voting as determined by the Chief
Officer.
